1.	<p><b>Welcome and Quorum</b></p> <p>The Chair welcomed all to the meeting and noted it was quorate.</p>	
2.	<p><b>Declarations of Interest and Conflicts of Interest</b></p> <p>No new declarations of interest or conflicts were noted.</p>	
3.	<p><b>Approval of ScotRail Budget for 2023/24, Rail Periods 1, 2 and 3</b></p> <p>The Chair noted that the Board of Scottish Rail Holdings Limited (“SRH”) had met the previous day and decided that it was not in a position to approve a full year budget for ScotRail without a supporting business plan. He explained that, as an interim measure, the SRH Board had agreed to discuss and approve a budget for the first quarter of the financial year later today, to provide time for ScotRail to submit a budget for the 2023/24 financial year.</p> <p>Therefore, the purpose of today’s special meeting of the Board is to approve a budget for ScotRail for that period for submission to SRH.</p> <p>Derek Marchant presented the ScotRail budget paper and explained that it sets out ScotRail’s requested allocation for Resource Departmental Expenditure Limit (“RDEL”) of £109.2M for the first 3 rail periods of the 2023/24 financial year. The Board discussed the paper and issues raised in full.</p> <p>The Board was reminded that approval was being given for RDEL funding only. ScotRail’s Capital Departmental Expenditure Limit</p>	

	<p>(“CDEL”) funding budget for 2023/24 remained unresolved with the action on ScotRail to deliver a prioritised list to SRH.</p> <p>It was further noted that the version of the ScotRail budget set out in the paper included a reallocation of certain small renewals from RDEL to CDEL. The Board agreed to consent to this change, there being no overall impact on the total budget request.</p> <p>The Board <b>noted</b> the paper and <b>approved</b> the submission to SRH of a budget allocation for ScotRail of funding of up to £109.2M for 2023/34 rail periods 1, 2 and 3.</p>	
<b>4.</b>	<p><b>AOB</b></p> <p>No other items of business were raised.</p>
